Rosevear Road and Wolf Lake Road construction upgrades nearing completion date

Yellowhead County contractors have been hard at work this summer completing much-needed upgrades to the Rosevear and Wolf Lake roads.

Wolf Lake Road

The contractor is currently placing Granular Base Course from the south end of the project, working north to Highway 16.

Upon completion they will spray a tack coat on the section to be paved (approximately 2.7km south of Highway 16).

The remaining 3km of new construction will receive a calcium bond layer of surfacing gravel. This work is scheduled to be completed by Aug. 31, 2007. The paving is scheduled to start Sept. 1 and be completed by Sept. 5, 2007.

Rosevear Road

The contractor is continuing to rebuild the road from the Rosevear Ferry, working

south to Highway 16. They have completed approximately 40 per cent (5.5km) of the work to date with the balance (8km) of the work scheduled to be completed by Sept. 30, 2007.

They are scheduled to start placing Granular Base Course on Sept. 1, 2007 with paving to be completed by Oct. 15, 2007.

Please note that the projected schedule dates are subject to weather conditions and could change drastically as we move into the fall season.

Yellowhead County would to thank all the drivers and residents of the area who have accommodated the construction and ask for their continued patience while the work is completed.

Yellowhead County Council is committed to the development of the County. The improvements of both Rosevear and Wolf Lake Roads are just two of the many development projects being implemented in 2007.
